WEEKLY SUMMARY

Miami weekly airtel, 5/3/63, set out 1963 Florida License 4-50906 on white Corvaair convertible observed in Miami night of 5/2/63, and identified M. HAWES as taking flight from Miami.

1963 Florida License 4-50906 registered on 1962 Corvaair convertible to MARK HAWES, 500-1st Ave. N., St. Petersburg. HAWES is an attorney who formerly practiced law in Tampa and has defended subject family in past. He has previously been reported in contact with subject in Miami in the past. HAWES is presently also representing an investigating committee commonly referred to as Senator Charlie Johns' Committee.

Information at Tampa indicates a MARTIN JONES is presently associated in the law firm with MARK HAWES in St. Petersburg, Fla., and he is reportedly an ex-FBI agent.

Miami weekly airtel 5/13/63, set out registration concerning 1963 Florida License 1W-35063; however, it is noted that the 1959 white Chevrolet Impala in subject's garage at 2505 Bristol, Tampa, bears a 1963 Florida License 1W-135063.

On 5/8/63, CHARLES SAMS (PROTECT IDENTITY), Postal Carrier, at 2505 Bristol Ave., advised has not seen subject nor wife and inquiry of the maid at subject's residence developed no information concerning subject being there. Source advised only bills and ordinary literature received at 2505 Bristol Ave.

4/11/63, billing date for telephone at 2505 Bristol Ave. indicates call on 3/19/63, to Miami PL 4-1912 (previously identified as to residence STEFANO ANTHONY RANDAZZO) and on 4/2/63, to Miami PL 7-5834.

REQUEST OF BUREAU

Bureau requested to advise whether or not MARTIN JONES is an ex-FBI agent, noting whether or not he left the Bureau in good graces may be of significance in connection with possibly using him as source relative to MARK HAWES connections with the subject.

It is further noted that MARK HAWES is very close to the Florida Legislature which could be significant should any move be made to legalize gambling in the State of Florida.
