WEEKLY AIRTEL SUMMARY

On 6/10/63, C. N. JONES, Station Manager, and GENE BLACKSTONE, Delta Airlines, International Airport, advised they were both on duty June 6, 1963, and observed passengers depart a Delta Airlines Flight 845 for Miami.

They advised 32 passengers were boarded on such flight and a review of the manifest fails to reflect the name of TRAFFICANTE. They noted the common practice was to have at least 5 or 10 walk ups where individuals merely walk up to a counter, purchase a ticket, and get aboard the next flight that leaves.

On June 10, 1963, TP 97-C advised subject has not been at the Columbia Restaurant since he was last seen and reported there on June 3, 1963.

On June 11, 1963, sources at Tampa International Airport, Eastern Airlines, National Airlines, Delta, North-east Orient, and airport police recontacted and subject

not reported since using flight June 6, 1963.

On June 12, 1963, HERB GOLDBERG, Assistant State Attorney, and next door neighbor to subject's residence, advised subject has not been seen.

On June 12, 1963, TP 50-C advised subject had not been known to be in contact with his brothers who hangout at the Dream Bar, Nebraska Avenue, Tampa, Florida, and noted that subject's brother SAM TRAFFICANTE has not been hanging about the Dream Bar as much as he used to and source suspects that he may be at the beach home, St. Petersburg, Beach, Florida.

Miami weekly airtel of June 4, 1963, indicated that FRANK RAGANO, subject's attorney, may have been on a flight that subject took from Miami to Tampa and also indicated Mrs. G. HOCKWORTH, 4518 Eden Roc Road, Tampa, Fla., may have been a passenger, in such regard it was noted that the residence of Mrs. GLORIA HACKWORTH at 4518 Eden Roc Road indicated same may be unoccupied as weeds are grown around residence.

1963 current Tampa City Directory lists her as a secretary no place of employment shown.

Subject's attorney FRANK RAGANO has been observed at Tampa all week and JIMMY LONGO was observed alone as of June 13, 1963 at the Columbia.

Miami weekly airtel summary of June 10, 1963, set out toll calls from subject's Miami unlisted phone to Tampa telephone 876-2207, 876-8044, and 246-9851. These phones are respectively listed at 2505 Bristol Avenue, JAMES C. LONGO's residence, at 4214 Riverview and to Tony's Fish Market 22nd Street and East Broadway, which is subject's father-in-law's business establishment.

Spot checks of subject's Tampa residence from June 10 to 13, 1963 failed to indicate subject in Tampa.
