VALDEZ married subject's daughter, SARAH ANN TRAFFICANTE, on June 23, 1963, at Tampa, Florida.

A telephone call was made to Louisville, Kentucky, which has previously been identified as the number of a relative of AUGUST C. PANIELLO, subject's son-in-law, who also resides at 2505 Bristol Avenue, Tampa; and there was a night collect call from Newark, New Jersey, however, confidential source in General Telephone Co. at Tampa advised no further information available.

There were numerous calls to and from subject's Miami residence at 523 Northeast 71st Street, and on 5/16/63, there was a call to Miami PL 4-0981. There were other calls to known persons.

On July 10, 1963, TP 120 PCI advised subject, wife and family were at 2505 Bristol Avenue on the afternoon of Monday, July 8, 1963, and SANTO was at residence in Tampa the evening of July 9, 1963, when source left. Source advised 1959 white Chrysler which bears 1963 Florida license 3W-6339 in Tampa.
