For information Bureau and Tampa, the first paragraph of referenced Tampa communication reflects that SALVATORE C. TRAFFICANTE and an unknown person was observed at Jacksonville visiting the residence of JOHN S. DE SALVO, Jacksonville "layoff" figure.

For clarification, Agents at Jacksonville observed a 1963 Mercury, bearing a Florida license which is issued to ELSIE TRAFFICANTE, the wife of SALVATORE C. TRAFFICANTE. Agents at Jacksonville, were not in a position to identify the occupants of this car and had requested the Tampa Office to attempt to identify persons in the automobile when same returned to Tampa area.

A Jacksonville source had reported the possibility that the individuals visiting DE SALVO were SALVATORE C. TRAFFICANTE and JOHN FAVATA CACCIATORE.
