Re report of SA JOHN P. LENIHAN at Miami dated 3/17/64.

For the information of Kansas City, Los Angeles, and New Orleans, FELIX ALDERISIO, who usually used the name of PHIL ALDERISIO in all of his travels as well as in the Chicago area and who is a Chicago top hoodlum, was indicted by the Federal Grand Jury, Miami, Florida, on 10/10/63 charging him with ITAR - EXTORTION in that on or about 3/9/62, he threatened one JAMES W. EGAN of Denver, Colorado. ALDERISIO was arrested by Bureau Agents, Chicago, on 10/9/63 on a Commissioner's warrant from Miami, Florida, dated 10/2/63 on the same charge as above. ALDERISIO is presently awaiting trial at Miami, Florida, which is now set for 7/7/64.

Investigation has indicated that an EAL employee by the name of R. DAVIS was aboard EAL Flight 155 on 3/5/62 from Chicago to Miami, Florida.

The following investigation was conducted by SA CLARK A. HULL at Chicago:

Miss ESTELLE BARRY, Base Manager, In-Flight Service, O'Hare Field, advised upon being exhibited a photostat of EAL Flight pass coupon #2 in the name of R. DAVIS that this particular pass was issued for an EAL stewardess by the name of R. DAVIS. Miss BARRY stated that according to EAL records at Miami, Florida, R. DAVIS was identical to Stewardess RHONDA L. DAVIS who terminated her employment with EAL on 3/23/62. The last known address for RHONDA L. DAVIS was Box 275, Gibson, Louisiana.

CG 6714-C advised that according to the records of Central Casualty Company, being held by the liquidator for the Illinois State Department of Insurance, the last billing date reflecting transportation for JAMES W. EGAN was on 12/18/61. He stated these records reflect that all air plan travel credit cards were suspended for the Central Casualty Company on 1/22/62.
