On 1/5/67 the Identification Division furnished a copy of Trafficante's identification record under FBI number 482 531 B to the Commissioner, RCMP, Ottawa, Canada, and indicated that the subject of their inquiry dated 12/19/66 was identical with Trafficante.

Tampa Office has requested that appropriate inquiry be made with the Commissioner to determine the nature of the RCMP's interest in Trafficante which prompted their inquiry. Your reply should be set forth with sufficient copies to enable the Bureau to forward the information to Tampa, the office of origin, on Trafficante.
