On May 25, 1967, T-1, a confidential source abroad, reported that the explosives which had been buried by FIORINI and his companions in the state of Tamaulipas, Mexico, are in the custody of the Mexican Army at Mexico City. Source advised that while it might be possible to have a competent witness, (either from the Mexican Army or from the Direccion Federal de Seguridad (DFS - Federal Security Police) produce the explosives in a court of law in the United States, the matter was politically sensitive and no decision had been reached.

On May 31, 1967, T-1 advised that if the United States Government desires to have the explosives produced by a competent witness, the United States Department of Justice should prepare a formal request for presentation through the Department of State to the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Relations. T-1 indicated that there was a good possibility that such a request would be favorably received.
