On 3/14/61, PG 612-C advised as follows:

RALPH THOMAS, no other identifying information, who recently took the aluminum cooking and table utensils from New Kensington, Pa., to KELLY MANNARINO in Florida, still has not returned and will not be back for a couple of weeks. It is believed that KELLY MANNARINO might have taken the aluminum-ware to a friend of his who operates a restaurant called JOE (LNU). The only other information concerning this individual is that he is from New York and was "written up" in the New York Times newspaper a couple of weeks ago.

The "boys" in the MANNARINO mob are still extremely alert for the pressure of "Government men" in New Kensington. Anyone who spends any length of time in the area and who is not known to the "boys" is followed. If he has an automobile, his license number is taken and checked with an unknown contact in the Pennsylvania State Police. The members of the mob even believe that out-of-state license numbers belong to Government cars, until proof is furnished to the contrary. Recently, a license number check resulted in the information that the car was registered to a Chicago, Illinois, firm known as the "4 Wheels," and the "boys" are convinced the driver was some sort of Federal investigator.
