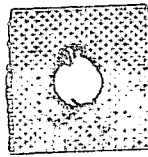
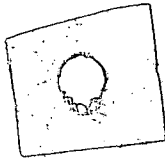

Re Chicago letters 12/24/58 and 1/21/59 and Paris letter 2/20/59.

GEORGES CLOT of the Prefecture of Police, Paris, advised on 2/25/59 that ALEX and his wife registered at the Hotel Ritz, 15 Place Vendome, Paris, on 1/9/59 and departed on 1/15/59. They occupied Room 110 and used their American passports for identification at the time of registration. CLOT advised that the subject was not engaged in any unusual activities while in Paris; and so far as could be determined did not make any contacts with Paris underworld figures.

Investigation is presently being conducted by the Swiss police.
