Copy of referenced airtel concerning possible deportation of Giancana not being forwarded to Legat, Mexico City. u

It is noted Mexican authorities have been cognizant of Giancana's residence and it is not felt that the Bureau should attempt in any way to influence the decision of the Mexican Immigration Service in connection with its legal responsibilities relative to Giancana's presence in Mexico. (u)

NOTE: Giancana, former Chicago underworld leader, has resided in Mexico since his voluntary exile from the United States in 1966. His presence has been known to the Mexican Government. Recently, Legat, Mexico City furnished Giancana's Mexican addresses to the new Mexican Assistant Secretary of Government who expressed an interest and observed that Giancana would be subject to deportation. Chicago feels if Giancana is deported he may resume leadership of organized crime activities in Chicago and in view of the undesirability of this, Legat, Mexico City should make no positive efforts to encourage the Mexican Government to deport subject. Chicago airtel not being forwarded to Legat because it is felt the Bureau should not interfere in any way with the legal responsibilities of Mexican Immigration Authorities relative to Giancana. (u)

Re Legat Mexico City letter dated 5/18/71 captioned
as above and MYER LANSKY, aka, AR. u

It is noted that captioned letter indicates that
information has been furnished to the Mexican Government which
intends to make inquiry concerning the residence of GIANCANA
in Mexico and noting that GIANCANA would certainly be subject
to deportation. (u)

It appears to the Chicago Office that it is in the
best interests of the Bureau and the Chicago Office that
GIANCANA remain in Mexico, or at least away from the Chicago
area. The reason for this is that with the continued absence
of GIANCANA from the Chicago area the vacuum created by his
absence continues in the leadership of organized crime. It
is noted that when GIANCANA was the "boss" of organized crime
in Chicago he asserted a strong and aggressive and capable
leadership which has been missing since he left the country
in 1966. In his absence the leadership of organized crime has
fallen to several individuals with ANTHONY J. ACCARDO and
PAUL RICCA furnishing a continuity spanning the reigns of
several of these leaders. The leaders themselves have been
incarcerated due to the intensified efforts of law enforcement
as they assume their positions and ACCARDO and RICCA, being
quite elderly, are not capable or interested in furnishing an
aggressive day to day leadership. u

For these reasons the absence of GIANCANA has left a void in the direction of organized crime which has had a salutary effect insofar as the Bureau is concerned. u

However, should GIANCANA be forced out of Mexico and should he then decide that it would be to the best interests of organized crime to return to Chicago and resume his leadership position, the above salutary effect would be dissipated. u

It is therefore suggested, UACB that the Legat Mexico City make no positive effort to encourage the Mexican Government to deport GIANCANA and that their dealings with the Mexican Government should be conducted in such a manner as to consider the above opinion of the Chicago Office. (K) u
