For the info of offices receiving this communication, the dynamite found in the bomb placed on the "Lancastrian Princess" is identical to simulated dynamite furnished to BOSCH by a Miami source, RICARDO MORALES NAVARRETTE with Bureau approval. It is entirely possible that any other bombs constructed by BOSCH's organization could contain explosive ingredients other than this particular simulated dynamite.
