FROM LEGAT, PARIS NO. 544

GUS ALEX, AKA, ANTI-RACKETEERING. RE PARIS LETTER MARCH 18 LAST. SWISS CENTRAL POLICE BUREAU ADVISED TODAY THAT INDIVIDUAL BELIEVED TO BE SUBJECT VISITED ST. MORITZ, SWITZERLAND, MARCH 4 LAST. ON SAME DATE LOCAL JEWELRY SHOP BURGLARIZED AND JEWELS TO VALUE OF APPROXIMATELY 100, 000 DOLLARS TAKEN. SWISS POLICE REQUEST COPY OF SUBJECT'S FINGERPRINTS AND INVESTIGATION IN U S TO DETERMINE WHEREABOUTS ON DATE IN QUESTION.
