GUS ALEX, AKA. AR. DAILY SUMMARY.

CG 6443-C ADVISED THAT GUS ALEX IS NOW THE OWNER OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY RESTAURANT, CHICAGO, AND THAT ANTHONY SMITH AND HIS BROTHER, TED SMITH, ARE THE FRONTS FOR ALEX AT THIS RESTAURANT. INFORMANT SAID HE RECEIVED THIS INFORMATION FROM BOB JARVIS, WHO IS KNOWN TO HIM AS A FENCE AND A SPORTS BETTOR.

INFORMANT FURTHER ADVISED THAT HE LEARNED FROM JARVIS THAT THE PURVEYORS WHO FURNISH MEATS AND VEGETABLES TO THE TOWN AND COUNTRY ARE PAID IN CASH BY ANTHONY SMITH AND HIS BROTHER AND THAT THERE ARE NO CHECKS GIVEN FOR THIS FOOD.

IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT THE KOPPER KETTLE RESTAURANT AND THE NEW IMPERIAL INN ARE ALSO OWNED AND OPERATED BY ANTHONY AND TED SMITH. UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPTS HAVE BEEN MADE TO DATE TO INTERVIEW ANTHONY SMITH REGARDING HIS ASSOCIATION WITH ALEX AND ALEX'S ALLEGED FINANCIAL INTEREST IN THE TOWN AND COUNTRY. EFFORTS CONTINUING.

ALEX ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
