ADMINISTRATIVE:

In connection with the information reflecting that Western Union Sports Service Tickers are in operation in the New Orleans, Louisiana territory, this office has opened new cases to determine if there is a possible violation of the ITWI Statute in line with instructions contained in Bureau airtel of September 13, 1962 to SAC, Albany, copy to all offices.

X Times PICAYUNE

This office currently has under investigation the matter involving the ~~X~~ Times Picayune Publishing Company and the possibility that an employee may be furnishing information from news sources to gamblers. *New Orleans*

An investigation is currently underway to attempt to identify individuals calling Chicago telephone #WE9-1900 to determine if this may violate the ITWI Statute.

The gambling casinos listed as operating in Jefferson Parish are currently under investigation to determine if there is a violation of the ITWP or the ITAR Statutes. Investigation is not being instituted on EUGENE NOLAN Of Baton Rouge in view of the fact that he is currently under indictment, soon to be tried by IRS.
