Inspector CHRIS PATSURIS, Athens City Police Department, Athens, Greece, on 6/6/61 advised that subject is not known to have been in Athens, Greece since sometime in May, 1961. He indicated that additional investigation is being conducted in Athens concerning subject's mother, Mrs. CHRISTINA ALEX.

With reference to GUS CONTOS, aka CONSTANTINE CONTOS, PATSURIS indicated that CONTOS had been deported to Greece from the USA. He advised that additional investigation is also being conducted with reference to this individual.

Records of the Tourist Bureau, Italian Police, Rome, Italy, checked on 6/5/61, indicated that GUS ALEX, a U.S. citizen born 4/1/16 at Chicago, Illinois, bearing U.S. Passport No. 1569555, arrived in Rome, Italy, on 4/13/61. He took lodging at the Hotel Savoia and he departed Rome 4/16/61. He is not known to have engaged in any suspect activity.
