GUS ALEX, AKA. AR. DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6443-C ADVISED THAT WHEN HE HAD RECENTLY PAID BACK JOHN DREW THE \$7,000 WHICH HE HAD OWED HIM, HE WAS INFORMED BY LESTER KRUSE, ASSOCIATE OF ALEX, TO LEAVE THE MONEY AT THE OFFICE OF STANFORD CLINTON, ATTORNEY, CHICAGO, WHERE IT WOULD BE PICKED UP BY SOMEONE ELSE WHO WOULD DELIVER IT TO DREW. INFORMANT STATED THAT HE HAD DONE THIS BUT THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHO PICKED UP THE MONEY AT CLINTON'S OFFICE FOR DREW. HE SAID KRUSE HAD RECENTLY ADVISED HIM THAT JOHN DREW WAS HEAVILY IN DEBT AS A RESULT OF HIS GAMBLING LOSSES AND AS A RESULT WAS HAD PRESSED FOR MONEY. KRUSE HAD ADVISED HIM THAT DREW HAD OWED JAKE "THE BARBER" FACTOR AND SAM GIANCANA LARGE SUMS OF MONEY WHICH HE HAD BORROWED FROM THEM. HE SAID DREW WAS ALEX' REPRESENTATIVE AT THE STARDUST INN, LAS VEGAS AND THAT ALEX HAD REFUSED TO LEND ANY MONEY TO DREW. INFORMANT SAID THAT ALEX WAS VERY DISPLEASED THAT DREW HAD BORROWED MONEY FROM GIANCANA AND WAS URGING HIM TO REPAY THIS DEBT TO GIANCANA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
