On 2-14-70, FRANK BRANDSTETTER (PROTECT by request), Manager of the Las Brisas Hotel in Acapulco, advised that he had no reports that the Subject had been in that area. He advised that he would be alert to Subject's possible presence in the area. He said that FRANK SINATRA has not been in Acapulco to his knowledge and that considered that he would know because this is generally widely publicized and, in addition, SINATRA usually contacts him. (R u)

He noted that the Acapulco Towers Hotel supposedly has been bought by the Gulf and Western conglomerate, but that he is suspicious as to the validity of this purchase. He indicated that MOE MORTON remains as Manager of this hotel, but that all the hotel employees have been recently installed and obviously have been given directions to not disclose any information as to persons or activities at the hotel. (R u)

On 2-27-70, Mr. BRANDSTETTER advised that he heard a report that the Presidential candidate, LUIS ECHEVERRIA would be staying at the Acapulco Towers while in Acapulco. He considered this would be a grave mistake because of the presence of MORTON and possibly other American gangsters at the Acapulco Towers and indicated that he planned to discreetly warn the candidate through a mutual contact against such activity. (R u)

It was later reported that the candidate stayed at the Las Brisas Hotel. (R u)

[CS MEX-287] has been contacted on various occasions, most recently on 3-23-70. He has had no personal contact with the Subject since before December, 1969, which he considers to be most unusual, although in part due to his own extended absence on leave in the States. In addition, the LERNERS, with whom Subject has a closer contact, have also been on extended travel outside of Mexico. (R u)

Source had a large party on 3-7-70, and was in a dilemma as to whether or not to ask the Subject. He knew Subject would hear of the party because he was asking the LERNERS and Subject's attorney, CASTILLO, and other mutual friends. He was not adverse to asking the Subject and felt that the Subject would be hurt not to be invited; however, at the same time, he was inviting the Ambassador and high Embassy officials, (R u)
