ANGELO ENUNO, aka FH 92-444 EU 92-2727

On 1/31/61 PH 269-C was advised by SALVATORE MAGGIO that ANGELO BRUNO was "out of town," but informant could not ascertain ERUNO's location. Receipt of ERUNO's tax payments 1959 shows claimed carnings of \$10,000 source being "won in Cubs." On 1/31/61, inquiry IRS, Philadelphia, ascertained ERUNO's wife, SUE, had not filed separate tax return and no apparent investigation being conducted regarding ERUNO's income tax return.

On 1/30/61 PH 591-C" advised that PETER MAGGIO disclosed that ANGELO BRUNO had been picked up by the police (Philadelphia) and questioned in regards to thefts committed at Maggio Company. Apparently BRUNO told by police that if anything happens to individuals who had committed theft they would hold him responsible. This action apparently resulted in confidential dissemination of information to Philadelphia PD on 1/19/61 as set forth Philadelphia Meekly Summary 1/21/61. FETER HAGGIO on instant date held lengthy discussion with unknown friend, disclosing the above information and that BRANK PAISHMO, ex-employee of Maggio Company, had been determined to be nephew of MINNY or HENNY knows BRUNO, FETER MAGGIO met him four or five years ago "out there."

"Mr. RALFH" received a letter from MINNY or HENNY as to trouble FRANK PALERNO may be in with the MAGGIOS. PETER drove 60 miles to talk to Mr. RALFH through respect. MINNY or HENNY was a friend of MICHAEL MAGGIO; ANGELO ENUNO knows him. He divulged no additional information regarding the stealing from the Maggio Checse Company and said he was picked up by the police who wanted him to sign confessions re thefts for "protection" as the MAGGIOS were going to kill him. PH 269-C has arranged through MAGGIO brothers for ERUNO to contact him 2/3/61. Results this contact will be reported.

On 2/3/61 Captain RICHARDDOYIE, Commander, Philadelphia PD Intelligence Squad, advised that BRUNO interviewed by police officials and recording device used to monitor interview malfunction and no recording resulted. From memory advised BRUNO admitted frequent trips to Florida; that he is no longer in storm window business in Flerida. He held one-third interest in vending machine business in Florida which he recently sold to Continental Industries. He intended to return to Florida to complete sale of vending machine company which involves 1000 machines. This was jointly in he and his wife's name.
