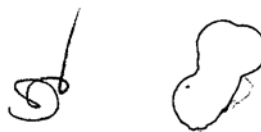
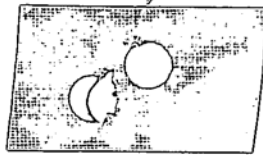

CG 6502-C* ADVISED THAT SAM AND MAE TAYLOR, BROTHER AND SISTER-IN-LAW OF ALEX, WHO RESIDE IN CASSOPOLIS, MICHIGAN, ARRIVED IN CHICAGO ON MARCH 30 LAST AND WERE IN ALEX'S APARTMENT ON THAT DATE. THIS INFORMANT PREVIOUSLY ADVISED THAT THE TAYLORS WOULD SUPERVISE THE CLEANING DECORATING OF ALEX'S APARTMENT TO BEGIN ON APRIL 2 INSTANT AND TO LAST UNTIL APRIL 5 NEXT.

[REDACTED] PCI, ADVISED THIS DATE THAT SAM AND MAE TAYLOR ARE IN TOWN AND HAVE MADE ALL THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CLEANING OF ALEX'S APARTMENT. HE SAID THE CLEANING IS BEING DONE BY THE BUILDING EMPLOYEES AND THAT THERE WILL BE NO PAINTING IN THE APARTMENT. HE SAID THAT THE TAYLORS PLAN ON BEING IN ALEX'S APARTMENT UNTIL THE CLEANING IS FINISHED AND THAT SAM INFORMED HIM THAT HE OR MAE WILL BE THERE AT ALL TIMES WHILE THE WORK IS BEING DONE. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE WOULD ATTEMPT TO SECURE THE NAMES OF ANY OUTSIDE CONTRACTORS IF THEY WERE ENGAGED IN THE CLEANING OF THE RUGS AND DRAPERIES OR ANY OTHER PROJECTS AT THE ALEX APARTMENT. ALEX ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
