WEEKLY SUMMARY

TP 94-C advised SA JOHN R. PALMER on 12/31/62 that he had had conversation with JIMMY FAZIO at the Fireside Steak House, Fort Lauderdale, Fla., on the night of 12/30/62, at which time FAZIO was told that source was disturbed by the fact that New York "boys" had been in Cocoa Beach looking over the area and that HERBERT FEUZ from Las Vegas was supposed to be trying to start some action. FAZIO seemed upset and replied "SANTO TRAFFICANTE is the boss" and that "Orders on everything come out of Chicago". FAZIO stated that he would telephone TRAFFICANTE on 12/31/62 and would ask him to visit in Cocoa Beach, indicating he could expect a visit within the week.

On Saturday, 1/5/63, Special Agents observed KENNETH R. GUTHRIE (employee of General Telephone Company of Florida, Tampa, Florida) drive with an unknown male to the residence of and have conversation with JAMES C. LONGO, who has been publicly described as a body guard for the subject.
