Captioned individual was subject of NYfile 105-43774 and was wife of subject of NYfile 134-17200 (Bufile 134-19345) whom she divorced in approximately January, 1976.

During the period of her marriage, 1970 - 1975. Ms. Lorenz voluntarily furnished information of both security and criminal nature. She was advised on numerous occasions that she was not an informant of the FBI. \(\)\

Subsequent to her divorce she continued to contact the NYO on a voluntarily basis and furnished information of a criminal nature. In approximately February, 1976, Ms. Lorenz against the advice of the NYO began an affair with one GIUSEPPE FAGGIANO aka Joe Pino, David Ring, who was by reputation, a "hit man" and arsonist. Throughout the duration of the affair she continued to furnish criminal information obtained through her relationship with FAGGIANO.

In April, 1976, instant case was opened to determine Ms. Lorenz' potential as an informant. However, due to the fact that Ms. Lorenz was the subject of extensive publicity on 6/12-13/76 regarding recruitment by CIA during 1960 to kill FIDEL CASTRO and was also about to publish a book regarding her activities with CASTRO instant case was closed. At that time, the source had indicated that her relationship with FAGGIANO was terminated.

Subsequently, Ms. Lorenz recontacted the NYO and advised she had renewed the relationship with him. In July, 1976, Ms. Lorenz advised she had been pistol whipped and beaten by FAGGIANO. She subsequently filed a complaint of first degree assault against him with the NYCPD. FAGGIANO was arrested on 8/11/76 and was released on his own recognizance. Ms. Lorenz alleged that subsequent to his release anonymous telephone calls were made to her unlisted home telephone, threatening her life.

Ms. Lorenz, at her request, was contacted on 8/19/76 by an SA of the NYO and Detective TERENCE MC SWIGEN, NYCPD. At that time she accused FAGGIANO of burglarizing her home and stealing several tape recordings of telephone conversations she had with FAGGIANO; ED LEVEY, a long time boyfriend and allegedly father of her son; several attorneys and publishers relating to the upcoming publication of her book. Ms. Lorenz claimed she feared for her life and requested FBI or police protection. She was advised by attending SA that there was no FBI jurisdiction in the assault by FAGGIANO, and that the FBI could not furnish her protection.

On 8/24/76, Detective MC SWIGEN advised NYO that prior to the hearing set for FAGGIANO regarding the assault, his attorney produced a tape on which Ms. Lorenz was conversing with a male regarding the possibility of "putting out a contract" to have FAGGIANO killed. This revelation created problems for the prosecuting district attorney who requested that the hearing be postponed.

The above is being furnished the Bureau for its information in the event that any inquiries are made regarding Ms. Lorenz request for protection. \land

The NYO does not intend to contact Ms. Lorenz in the future due to her notoriety
