Re New York airtel and memorandum 3/21/60
which contained data concerning subject's departure
from the U. S. to Mexico.

On 3/15/60 information was received from
Bureau Source 6 that subject, who possessed a Cuban
diplomatic passport, was granted a 30-day visa by
the Mexican Foreign Ministry. Subject indicated he
wanted to go to Mexico City to visit friends and to
watch enemies of the Cuban Government.

Per NSA letter 2/27/48.

The information from Bureau Source 6 was
classified "Top Secret" and must not be included
in any communications prepared for dissemination.

Information has been received from other
U. S. agencies to the effect that Fidel Castro
possibly is trying to get rid of the subject because
of the unfavorable publicity given Castro in connection
with the subject's attempt to persuade Illona Marita
Lorenz to sign a statement that Pelletier was responsible
for her pregnancy instead of Castro.

Through sources, Mexico should attempt to
verify the subject's presence in Mexico City and should
report pertinent information developed regarding his
activities.

NOTE: Iilona Marita Lorenz claimed Fidel Castro was responsible for her pregnancy after she lived with him several months during the Summer of 1959. She claimed she was drugged and an abortion performed by Castro's henchmen and, thereafter, she fled Cuba and returned to her home in New York City. Her mother wrote many government leaders throughout the world soliciting action against Fidel Castro and an article concerning the affair appeared in a "scandal-type" magazine. Miss Lorenz claims Pelletier came to New York City, trying to marry her and also trying to take her back to Cuba. She refused to have anything to do with Pelletier and he reportedly made a second trip to New York City on 3/11/60 and asked her to accompany him to Mexico. On this occasion, subject accused her of causing him to lose favor with Castro and said Castro had forced subject to divorce his wife in Cuba and ordered him to marry Miss Lorenz. New York Office, when told by Miss Lorenz that subject attacked her when she declined to accompany him to Mexico, instructed her to report this to New York City Police Department (NYC PD), which she did. NYC PD had subject report to police station where he identified himself as a military aide to Castro and exhibited his diplomatic passport. Miss Lorenz failed to press charges against subject and the charges were dismissed as NYC PD was reluctant to act against subject because of his diplomatic status. Subject has potential as source of information concerning Castro if he is in disfavor with Castro and possibility exists he might defect while he is in Mexico. J.C. (u)
