RE TELEPHONE CALL FROM LEGAT, CARACAS, TO MIAMI, OCTOBER 13, 1976; MIAMI TELEPHONE CALL TO BUREAU, OCTOBER 13, 1976.

IN REFERENCED CALL FROM CARACAS TO MIAMI, LEGAT JOE LEO ADVISED THAT A SOURCE IN THE VENEZUELAN NATIONAL POLICE, DIRECTORATE OF INTELLIGENCE AND PREVENTATIVE SERVICE (DISIP), ADVISED HIM THAT DISIP HAD INFORMATION THAT FRANK CASTRO WAS A KEY NAME IN CAPTIONED BOMBING AND REQUESTED THAT HE BE INTERVIEWED. (S)

IN REFERENCED CALL FROM MIAMI TO BUREAU, MIAMI WAS INSTRUCTED TO INTERVIEW CASTRO REGARDING CAPTIONED BOMBING.

FRANK CASTRO WAS CONTACTED AT THE HOME OF HIS MOTHER,  
1420 S.W. 13TH AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA. CASTRO ADVISED THAT  
HE HAD NO OBJECTION TO BEING INTERVIEWED BY THE FBI; HOWEVER  
PREVIOUS COMMITMENTS MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR HIM TO BE  
INTERVIEWED OCTOBER 13, 1976.

A MEETING HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR NINE O'CLOCK, OCTOBER 14,  
1976, AT THE MIAMI FBI OFFICE. BUREAU WILL BE ADVISED OF THE  
RESULTS OF THE INTERVIEW.

IN ADDITION, LEGAT JOE LEO ADVISED THAT VENEZUELAN OFFICIALS  
SEEMED AGREEABLE TO THE REMOVAL OF DR. ORLANDO BOSCH FROM  
VENEZUELA TO THE USA. (S)
