ReBulet 11/19/65; Miami airtel and enclosed letterhead memorandum dated 12/3/65; and Bureau letter to Assistant Attorney General J. WALTER YEAGLEY dated 12/1/65, both captioned "REPRESENTACION CUBANA DEL EXILIO (RECE), IS - CUBA; NEUTRALITY MATTERS."

Enclosed for the Bureau are 12 copies of a letterhead memorandum dated and captioned as above. Copies have been disseminated locally to U. S. Border Patrol, U. S. Customs (Miami, Region II and Key West), INS, ONI, G-2, OSI, CIA, U. S. Coast Guard, State Department (Cuban Affairs) and USA FAD.

It is noted in referenced Miami airtel it appears that the information furnished by MM 974-S which was submitted to the Bureau by letter dated 9/22/65 under the MRR caption actually pertained to plans for the November 14, 1965 attack on Havana which was staged by Comandos L, RECE and the 30th of November Movement and does not pertain to MRR activity.

Referenced Bureau letter to Assistant Attorney General, page 2, states that in view of the interest of the USA FAD in ANTONIO GONZALEZ, one of the participants

in the November 14, 1965 attack, the Bureau desired to be expeditiously advised whether the facts concerning this attack constitute a violation of neutrality statutes and if so, whether prosecution is contemplated. The Department was advised that the Bureau was holding further investigation of this matter in abeyance pending their reply. (u)

In view of the information furnished by Dr. SANTIAGO ALVAREZ that he had initially participated in discussions with MIGUEL IZA and HERMINIO DIAZ concerning a possible operation against Cuba but later withdrew from these plans, as well as the information that his son, SANTIAGO ALVAREZ, JR., was not involved, it is not believed that additional investigation of this matter as related to the MRR, is warranted. (u)

[In connection with future investigative efforts of the MRR by the Miami Office, it is noted that this organization has been of operational interest to CIA for a considerable period of time. Although the MRR has withdrawn its elements from Central America, the organization in Miami is obviously continuing to receive financial support from CIA. Accordingly, Miami plans to canvass (u) logical informants for any pertinent information concerning current or projected MRR activities and in the absence of any information which would dictate to the contrary, will consider submitting a closing report. (u)
