WEEKLY SUMMARY

MM 833-PCI, on 11/5/62, advised that ~~RUBY STRAUSS~~, a bookmaker and gambler, is a daily visitor at the residence of ~~JOSEPH INDELICATO~~ (Miami file 92-404), Beaux Arts Apartments, North Bay Village, Florida. Since some rumor exists that STRAUSS and INDELICATO may be interested in a gambling ship, investigation revealed that the crew list of a luxury liner, the "Orange Sun", which is considered the most logical ship which could be utilized for gambling purposes, indicates the owners as MYRON J. ~~BERNS~~ and GUY ~~GULLY~~. BERNs was naturalized at Cleveland, Ohio in 1959. He also maintains an office in the Biscayne Terrace Hotel, Miami, Florida.

MM 509-C, on 11/6/62, advised he was informed that ~~MYRON BERNs~~' true name is ~~MYRON BERNSTEIN~~; that he came to Miami from Cleveland, Ohio; is wealthy; a gambler and one who bought into the Patio Bridge Club last season and then sold his interest a short time later to RUTH GASSENHEIMER, who is paying off the obligation on a monthly basis. According to his source BERNs is going to utilize his boat for gambling purposes.

MM 833-PCI advised on <sup>Fla</sup> 11/15/62 that the Beaux Arts Apartments, where INDELICATO and some other hoodlums reside, is changing hands. The details are not known to the informant, but he understands MARVIN SCHULMAN and his associates, who operate the apartments, are out and that a New York group is to take it over with a Mr. SWARTZ (phonetic) as the new manager. This source advises that the present manager, ROBERT BERNSTEIN, has been told to leave by the end of this year.

On the night of 11/14/62, JIMMY COPPOLA, brother of MICHAEL COPPOLA (Miami file 92-101), JOE MORRISON, PASQUALE FERRA (Miami file 92-648), RUBY LAZARUS observed meeting at residence of MICHAEL COPPOLA, Miami Beach, Florida. ANTHONY SALERNO (Miami file 92-406) not observed there, but his automobile was in front of residence. MICHAEL now in the U. S. Penitentiary but his release is anticipated in December, 1962.

MM 730-C, on 11/9/62, advised he observed MAX EDER <sup>Fla</sup> (Miami file 92-467) and his wife, as well as BEN NOVACK, operator of the Fontainebleau Hotel, and his wife, together at a Miami Beach movie theatre where they heard the PATTERSON-LISTON fight.

MM 745-C\* advised on 11/15/62, ANTHONY STEFANO RANDAZZO and an individual believed identical to CHARLIE "The Blade" TOURINE were at Ciro's Restaurant, North Miami Beach, Florida. According to information received these individuals had a lengthy conversation concerning the "Commission" and discussed in detail various leading racketeers in the United States. It was apparent RANDAZZO will be operating the restaurant part of Ciro's and gambling will be performed which will be controlled and operated by the other individual believed TOURINE. These individuals discussed the set-up of organized crime involving people who had been in what they called the "Mafia", how they became members, and what a secret
