

This will confirm and enlarge upon information regarding Vladimir RODRIGUEZ Lahera verbally supplied your office over the past week.

2. RODRIGUEZ arrived in Canada at Halifax on April 21, 1964 on board a Cubana Airlines flight en route Frague from Havana. Upon deplaning at Halifax, N.S., RODRIGUEZ immediately made application to Canadian immigration authorities for political asylum in this country. At the same time he indicated his ultimate destination was the U.S.A. where he planned to reside permanently. He left in their home at Havana, Cuba his wife and two children. RODRIGUEZ identified himself as an officer of the Cuban Intelligence Service (CUIS) and advised that he had brought with him numerous official CUIS documents, including actual case files.

3. Interrogation of RODRIGUEZ conducted in Ottawa established his bona fides as a Cuban intelligence officer and indicated the authenticity of the documents he brought with him. His knowledge of CUIS methods, operations, officers and agents throughout Latin America is extensive, and obviously a very extensive debriefing of this man was indicated. None of the information RODRIGUEZ possessed directly concerned Canada, and on April 21, 1964 he departed Canada for Washington, D.C. under escort by an officer of the C.I.A. Undoubtedly much interesting information from this source will be made available by C.I.A. to your own and other interested American Agencies.
