CG SIX TWO EIGHT THREE - C ADVISED JUNE EIGHT INSTANT SAM AND ROSE FLOOD, RELATIVES OF GIANCANA CLOSELY ASSOCIATED WITH HIM, REPORTEDLY HAVE LEFT CHICAGO AREA. INFORMANT STATED SAM FLOOD, WHO IS AN ALCOHOLIC, RETIRED FROM HIS OCCUPATION HERE AND WENT TO SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO, WHERE RICHARD CAIN SET HIM UP IN A BRASSIERE MANUFACTURING BUSINESS, BELIEVED TO BE CALLED "FORMFIT".
