file of LOUIS HENRY JONES, husband of the subject. A State Department interoffice memorandum, dated August 25, 1966, stated in part that on August 25, 1966, Mr. ED COILE of United States Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), telephonically advised that he had received a message from his Montreal (Canada) Office that LOUIS HENRY JONES was arriving in Montreal on the "Leninsky Pioneer" on August 25, 1966. Mr. COILE further stated that JONES' wife had sent him \$200 from the United States.

On October 31, 1966, IC ROBERT P. CAMPBELL, reviewed the passport file maintained for <sup>above</sup> subject and determined that it contained no current information.

By letter, dated November 4, 1966, NY T-2, [a confidential source abroad, advised that on August 25, 1966, the Soviet freighter "Leninsky Pioneer" arrived at the Port of Sorel, Quebec, Canada, from Havana, Cuba. The passengers were LOUIS HENRY JONES and his three children, CAROLINE ROSE JONES, born April 3, 1962, in Cuba; RENE ANTONIA JONES, born September 9, 1963 in Cuba; and FAITH ANN JONES, born August 25, 1965, in Cuba. (S)

JONES' date and place of birth were shown as March 17, 1934, at Monticello, Kentucky. His United States birth certificate, number 2622, was issued April 8, 1954, at the Courthouse, Cincinnati, Ohio. His father was shown as GOBEL JONES, and his mother as LOUISE E. WEST. His wife was shown as LANNA JONES, 340 Haven Avenue, Manhattan, New York. His occupation was shown as a psychoanalyst. He had lived in Cuba for six years and gave his address in Cuba as Avenue 3, Number 1804, Miromar, Havana. He departed for the United States on August 25, 1966, via Canadian Pacific Railways destined for the residence of his wife. (S)
