GUS ALEX, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6272-C ADVISED THAT ON EVENING OF SEPTEMBER 27 LAST, HE MET AT MIKE FISH'S RESTAURANT, ONTARIO AND RUSH STREETS, CHICAGO, WITH GUS ALEX, EDDIE VOGEL, BUTCH LADON, AND ONE ROCKY WHOSE LAST NAME INFORMANT BELIEVES IS DE GRAZIO, NOT IDENTICAL WITH ROCKY DE GRAZIO OF THE CASA MADRID LOUNGE, MILROSE PARK, ILLINOIS. ALEX WAS INTERESTED IN INFORMANT'S TESTIMONY BEFORE THE MC CARRON COMMITTEE AND SPECIFICALLY QUESTIONS ASKED INFORMANT BY SENATORS RELATIVE TO AN ALLEGED PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN ALEX AND INFORMANT. INFORMANT FACETIOUSLY ACCUSED ALEX OF TELLING PEOPLE HE AND INFORMANT WERE PARTNERS, WHICH ALEX VEHEMENTLY DENIED. ALEX TOLD INFORMANT HE CAN NOW REALIZE "WHAT I'VE BEEN GOING THROUGH FOR 3 1/2 YEARS SINCE THE FBI STARTED ON ME. NOW YOU CAN UNDERSTAND." CG 6443-C HAS ADVISED ONE DR. FOLEY, HEART SPECIALIST, ON WEST MADISON STREET, CHICAGO, TREATS ALEX AND OTHER CHICAGO AREA HOODLUMS WHEN THEY FEEL THEY HAVE A HEART CONDITION. ALEX SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
