GUS ALEX, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6443-C ADVISED HE HAD LEARNED FROM LESLIE KRUSE, ASSOCIATE OF GUS ALEX THAT THE "OUTFIT" DOES NOT PLAN TO REOPEN THE GAMBLING CASINO AT THE J. AND J. PICNIC GROVE IN WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, WHICH WAS CLOSED RECENTLY BECAUSE OF PUBLICITY AFFORDED THE OPERATION BY SANDY SMITH CRIME REPORTER FOR THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE. SOURCE SAID THE "OUTFIT" FELT THAT IF THEY REOPENED THE J. AND J. PICNIC GROVE THE GOVERNMENT WOULD RAID THE PLACE AND THE INCIDENCES INVOLVED WOULD NOT BE WORTH THE RISK. ACCORDING TO INFORMANT KRUSE EXPRESSED SURPRISE THAT THE J. AND J. WAS NOT RAIDED FOLLOWING THE ABOVE PUBLICITY. AND STATED SANDY SMITH WOULD BE IN THE LAKE IF HE WERE NOT WITH THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE NEWSPAPER. IT IS NOTED SOURCES HAVE PREVIOUSLY ADVISED THAT ALEX HAD AN INTEREST IN THE GAMBLING OPERATIONS AT THE J. AND J. PICNIC GROVE. ALEX ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
