GUS ALEX, AKA. AR. DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6443-C, HAS ADVISED THAT THE PROPERTY RENTED BY LOUIS ARGER, CLOSE ASSOCIATE OF ALEX IN CONNECTION WITH HIS ARCADES AND STRIP JOINTS LOCATED ON SOUTH STATE STREET, CHICAGO, IS OWNED BY ONE MORTON ABELSON OF THE BARTON DISTILLER COMPANY, CHICAGO, WHICH DISTILLS WHISKY IN KENTUCKY. INFORMANT ADVISED THAT ABELSON OWNS THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE SUPER ARCADE IS BUILT AND FURTHER THAT THE SUPER ARCADE WAS BUILT AT THE SUGGESTION OF GUS ALEX FOR LOUIS ARGER. IT IS NOTED THAT LEO LENIT IN A RECENT INTERVIEW ADVISED THAT HE IS SOLE OWNER OF THE SUPER ARCADE AND DENIED THAT ALEX OR ARGER HAD ANY INTEREST IN THIS ENTERPRISE OR THAT HE HAD TO PAY ANYONE FOR PROTECTION OR FURNISH ANY PORTION OF HIS PROFITS TO ANYONE. IT IS ALSO NOTED THAT CG 6443-C HAS ADVISED THAT LENIT IS AN EMPLOYEE OF ARGER AND IS USED BY ARGER IN CONNECTION WITH LICENSES FOR HIS AMUSEMENT ARCADES AND STRIP JOINTS ON SOUTH STATE STREET. ALEX ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
