GUS ALEX, AKA; AR; DAILY SUMMARY. CG 6502-C* ADVISED ON JANUARY 24 LAST THAT ALEX AND NATHAN LADON, BODYGUARD AND CHAUFFEUR FOR ALEX WERE TOGETHER AT ALEX'S APARTMENT AND WERE DISCUSSING A PERSON WHO DIED ON THAT DATE AND WOULD BE LAID OUT AT COLETTA'S FUNERAL HOME. ALEX DID NOT MENTION THIS PERSON BY NAME. IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THIS PERSON REFERRED TO BY ALEX IS ANTHONY L. ALFERVIC, KNOWN AS RAMEY BY HIS CLOSE ASSOCIATES. RAMEY WAS A FORMER JUICE MAN FOR ALEX AT ALL THE BIG GAMBLING GAMES FOR YEARS BUT HAD FALLEN UNTO BAD GRACES WITH ALEX SEVERAL MONTHS AGO WHEN HE CONVERTED SOME OF ALEX'S JUICE MONEY TO HIS OWN USE FOR GAMBLING PURPOSES. CG 6443-C ADVISED THAT ALEX WAS SUPPOSED TO VISIT RAMEY'S WAKE AT COLETTA'S FUNERAL HOME ON JANUARY 25 BUT DID NOT SHOW UP DUE TO RECENT HEAT ON HOODLUMS IN CHICAGO. PHYSICAL SURVEILLANCE BY AGENTS OF THIS OFFICE IN THE VICINITY OF COLETTA'S FUNERAL HOME ON JANUARY 25 LAST, BUT ALEX WAS NOT OBSERVED VISITING THE WAKE. ALEX IS ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
