GUS ALEX, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY. IN REGARD TO ALEX! HEALTH, CG 6502-C* ADVISED THAT IN RECENT CONVERSATIONS WITH SUZANNE MAIER IN THE PRESENCE OF THE INFORMANT, ALEX CONTINUES TO BE GREATLY CONCERNED WITH HIS HEALTH. HE HAS STATED THAT HE HAS HAD SEVERAL EXAMINATIONS IN THE PAST AND THAT THE DOCTORS DO NOT FIND ANYTHING WRONG WITH HIM. HOWEVER, INFORMANT SAID ALEX IS OF THE OPINION THAT SOMETHING MUST BE WRONG WITH HIM SINCE HE IS SO RESTLESS AND UPSET ALL THE TIME. SAID THAT ALEX IS EVIDENTLY TAKING SOME PILLS WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF HIS DOCTOR BECAUSE RECENTLY MAIER REPRIMANDED HIM

FOR DOING THIS. IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT

PCI, IS ALEX! DOCTOR, AND HE RECENTLY ADVISED THAT ALEX HAD BEEN IN TO SEE HIM AND THAT HE HAD TREATED HIM CG 6502-C* ADVISED THAT ALEX RECENTLY MENTIONED IN THE PRESENCE OF THE INFORMANT AND MAIER THAT DOCTOR MARQUARDT HAD CALLED HIM FEBRUARY 24 LAST TO ADVISE ALEX THAT HE, WAS GOING ON A VACATION FOR TWO WEEKS IN FLORIDA. FURTHER ADVISED THAT ALEX IS EVIDENTLY HAVING SOME TROUBLE WITH HIS FEET AS MARQUARDT TOLD ALEX NOT TO FORGET TO GO TO THE FOOT DOCTOR ON FEBRUARY 26 LAST. SINFORMANT SAID THAT ALEX MENTIONED TO MARQUARDT THAT HE WAS DOING A LOT OF WALKING LATELY FOR HI ALEX ARMED AND DANGEROUS WITH SUICIDAL TENDENCIES.
