GUS ALEX, AKA, AR.

PCI [REDACTED] BUILDING MANAGER, AT ALEX'S APARTMENT, ADVISED THAT WITHIN NEXT TWO DAYS ALEX'S PARAMOUR, SUZANNE FUEGER, WILL MOVE INTO ALEX'S BUILDING AND PROBABLY INTO AN APARTMENT ON THE FIFTH FLOOR. ALEX WILL REMAIN IN HIS APARTMENT ON THE TENTH FLOOR. PCI STATES FUEGER'S APPLICATION WAS ACCEPTED AND APPROVED AND ONE OF HER REFERENCES WAS EUGENE BERNSTEIN, WELL-KNOWN HOODLUM TAX ATTORNEY. PCI ADDED FUEGER SEEMED CONCERNED OVER EXCESSIVE COST OF APARTMENT AND INDICATES MODEST MODE OF LIVING. ALSO THAT ALEX HAD SEEMED ANXIOUS ABOUT THE APPROVAL OF HER APPLICATION MAKING INQUIRY SEVERAL TIMES AND WAS VERY APPRECIATIVE WHEN IT WAS APPROVED. CG 6502-C* HAS ADVISED IN THE PAST THAT FUEGER WAS EXPECTED TO MOVE INTO APARTMENT 6J IN ALEX'S BUILDING AND THAT ALEX HAD EXPRESSED MUCH CONCERN OVER WHAT HIS NEIGHBORS MIGHT THINK ABOUT THIS MOVE. ALEX APPARENTLY IS VERY SENSITIVE ABOUT HIS NEIGHBORS AND WHAT THEY THINK OF HIM.
