GUS ALEX, AKA., AR, DAILY SUMMARY.

CG 6502-C\* ADVISED ALEX AND PARAMOUR SUZANNE FUEGER, RECENTLY DISCUSSED LAVISH RECEPTION HELD FOR ANTHONY ACCARDO, JR., AT VILLA VENICE EVENING BEFORE WEDDING. ALEX APPARENTLY ENGAGED IN ARGUMENT WITH WIFE OF MIKE LNU AT RECEPTION AND WOMAN WAS OBVIOUSLY DRUNK. ALEX REFERRED TO MIKE AS HAVING A "BIG FAT MOUTH ANYWAY WITHOUT DRINKING." FUEGER INDICATED THIS WOMAN INTERJECTED HERSELF INTO A CONVERSATION MIKE AND GUS WERE HAVING. CG 6758-C\* SUBSEQUENTLY ADVISED ALEX VISITED OFFICE OF HOODLUM ATTORNEY MIKE BRODKIN TO APOLOGIZE FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED ARGUMENT HE HAD WITH BRODKIN'S WIFE. ALEX ALSO TOLD BRODKIN TO WARN HIS WIFE NEVER TO TALK TO HIM LIKE THAT AGAIN AND BRODKIN APOLOGIZED FOR HIS WIFE'S ACTIONS. ALEX INDICATED HE HAD OBTAINED A CASE OF CHOICE WINE FOR THIS OCCASION AND BRODKIN FAILED TO GET ANY BECAUSE THEIR ASSOCIATES HAD TAKEN ALL OF IT WITHOUT ASKING, INCLUDING SAM GIANCANA WHO TOOK THREE BOTTLES.
