[REDACTED] was reportedly submitted to the Department of Justice for review and analysis. [REDACTED] a well-known gambler in the [REDACTED] area who was active in the late 1940s, was tried in Federal Court, New Orleans, Louisiana, in [REDACTED] Federal Grand Jury when he testified that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Since that period gambling and other vice violations have been rigidly enforced by the Calcasieu Parish Sheriff's Office, and there is presently no graft or corruption in this area.
