On September 13, 1962, two mite units were installed at the source, one mite covering the main dining area and the other unit covers the rear store room of the Armory Lounge. Diode switching is utilized. The following activity of significance has been reported by this source since September 13, 1962:

On September 13, 1962, DOMINIC BLASI met briefly with an individual named LES (LNU) regarding a meeting to take place with FRANK BUCCIERI. Later on the same date FIORE BUCCIERI held a brief discussion with EDWARD VOGEL and DOMINIC BLASI. The discussion related to problems with Puerto Rican lottery, however the conversation was not discernable.

Later on September 13, 1962, SAMUEL M. GIANCANA met with JOHN FORMUSA, Indianapolis Top Hoodlum and close associate of GIANCANA, concerning the opening of the Villa Venice Club sometime around the first of November of 1962. GIANCANA advised that he had made arrangements whereby EDDIE FISHER was to appear as the opening engagement followed by FRANK SINATRA, DEAN MARTIN, and SAMMY DAVIS, JR. and it was tentatively decided to attempt to obtain the services of DEBBIE REYNOLDS to appear.

On September 18, 1962, GIANCANA met with JAMES CELANO, Owner of Celano's Tailor Shop, the location of CG 6343-C*. CELANO was attempting to intercede with GIANCANA on behalf of an individual named SAMMY SPINELLI (phonetic). Apparently this individual is a policeman and CELANO was interested in obtaining GIANCANA's sponsorship. CELANO preceded to advise GIANCANA of his troublestwith the Internal Revenue Service and the FBI, and related the instances whereby CELANO was interviewed by FBI Agents regarding MURRAY HUMPHREYS and GIANCANA whereby he assured GIANCANA that he had told the FBI nothing.

On October 4, 1962, SAMUEL GIANCANA along with several unknowns discussed his relationship with his

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
