Re Cleveland letter and letterhead memorandum dated 11/29/60.

On December 6, 1960, Mr. H. J. RAND, (Protect - requested) provided an autostatic copy of a letter dated November 28, 1960, from the Embassy of the U.S.S.R. in Washington, D.C., under the signature of N. REZNICHENKO, Chief, Consular Division, addressed to himself, which is as follows: (S)(U)

"Dear Sir,

"I have been asked to advise you that your request concerning Mr. R. WEBSTER's departure from the USSR has been forwarded to the appropriate Soviet authorities for their consideration. (S)(U)
