On 5/23/62, NY [3503-S] was contacted at which  
time he advised that recently the New York newspapers  
carried a story concerning the return of ROBERT EDWARD  
WEBSTER to the United States.

U. S. A

WEBSTER, a plastic engineer, renounced his  
United States citizenship and remained in the USSR,  
at the termination of the American National Exhibition  
held in the USSR in 1959.

NY [3503-S] [(GEORGE LUBIN)] a plastic engineer [C]  
has known WEBSTER for some time and was assigned with  
him as a plastic engineer to the United States Exhibition  
in the USSR in 1959. NY [3503-S] again visited the Soviet  
Union as an engineer in 1961. [C]

In connection with NY [3503-S] visits to the  
[USSR] as a plastic expert in [1959] and [1961] he became  
acquainted with many of the Soviets who were also  
friends and acquaintances of ROBERT EDWARD WEBSTER.

In the event the Bureau desires to verify  
information furnished by WEBSTER, NY [3503-S] is available  
to assist in any way possible.

If the Bureau deems it desirable and necessary,  
arrangements can be made to have NY [3503-S] contact WEBSTER  
since both are former associates [American National  
Exhibition, USSR, 1959] and attempt to ascertain from  
him any information of interest to the Bureau.
