PCI [REDACTED], on December 16, 1962, advised that it was believed that FRANK SINATRA would come to New Orleans with DEAN MARTIN early in December, 1962, when MARTIN was filming a portion of a motion picture, and MARCELLO wanted to contact FRANK SINATRA. [REDACTED] advised that SINATRA did not come to New Orleans, and as far as he knew there was no contact between MARCELLO and SINATRA.

The Los Angeles Office, by airtels dated November 20, 21, and 26, 1962, in the BILSOL, NBA investigation, reported information involving HOMER and MAXINE SNOWDEN, 5206 Brookview Drive, Dallas, Texas, who are possible connections with BILLIE SOL ESTES. Among SNOWDEN's activities was his association with WILLIAM RUSSELL PRUNER, Apartment 103, 2509 Turtle Creek, Dallas, Texas, President of Texas-Mustang Industries, Inc., 2528 Farrington, Dallas, Texas.

An individual named EDWARD NICHOLAS BECKER, 8613 West Olympic, Los Angeles, a licensed private investigator in the State of California, was introduced by SNOWDEN to PRUNER on September 21, 1962. Also present was CARLO ROPPOLO, age 27, a graduate geologist of Louisiana State University, residence 515 Egan Street, Shreveport, Louisiana. The meeting was to promote an oil additive known as Mustang, and ROPPOLO expressed an interest in being the Louisiana distributor. ROPPOLO claims he wanted to contact a wealthy and influential uncle in New Orleans, and BECKER and ROPPOLO were supposed to have gone to New Orleans to get this individual, who was subsequently identified as CARLOS MARCELLO. ROPPOLO alleged several days later that his mother is CARLOS MARCELLO's sister. The significance of the activities of SNOWDEN, PRUNER, and BECKER, insofar as the relationship with MARCELLO, is unknown. SNOWDEN is apparently an oil promoter who has numerous promotional interests and has apparently served in both the California State Penitentiary and the Federal Correctional Institution at Terminal Island. In view of the possibility that this information is part of the intrigue involving private investigators connected with the BILSOL case, the information is not being included in the body of the report; however, efforts will be made to determine any possible connections between MARCELLO and CARLO ROPPOLO.

The Miami Office obtained the records of the telephone calls of CARLOS MARCELLO while he was at the Fontainebleau Hotel, Miami Beach, on August 7, 1962, through August 12, 1962, and among these calls were calls to Jackson 5-3835, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, on August 8, 9, 10, and 11, 1962. There were also calls made on August 5, 6, and 7, 1962, from the Beach Club Hotel, 3100 N. Ocean Boulevard, Miami, Florida. A call was made on August 6, 1962, to Houston, Texas, to telephone number CA 5-0431 and to Dallas, Texas, in the name of [REDACTED], number RA12-8806. These calls were all made to or by PCI [REDACTED] and are not being included in the body of the report in order to protect this source of information.

Current investigation is being conducted of the Chesterfield Club entitled "ALBERT J. SAIZER, ET AL, The Chesterfield Club, ITAR," Bufile 166-387, New Orleans file 166-49.

NY 3368-C advised SA WARREN J. DONOVAN on October 4, 1962, that he had no further information concerning MARCELLO, and he did not know him personally.
