At 10:55 a.m., 3/2/64, ANGELO BRUNO was observed entering Piccolo's 500 Club, 11th and Christian Streets, Philadelphia, through the front door. At 11:15 a.m., the same date, a 1963 or 1964 yellow Cadillac convertible, bearing New York license 9911 ND, parked on Christian Street adjacent to the 500 Club. Two white male occupants left car and entered 500 Club. At 1:45 p.m., same date, ANGELO BRUNO exited club via front door and two persons who arrived in New York car accompanied by a third unknown person left the side door of the 500 Club.

PH 614-C-TE advised SA JOSEPH A. VERICA that SUE BRUNO, wife of ANGELO BRUNO, had told him that two men from New York picked up ANGELO BRUNO some time after 11 o'clock a.m. at BRUNO's house. Informant also stated that at about 1:45 p.m., BRUNO returned to the vicinity of 8th and Catharine Streets, Philadelphia, in the company of an
