ANGELO BRUNO, AKA. AR, DAILY SUMMARY.

PH 672-C-TE ADVISED THIS DATE APPROXIMATELY SIX AND ONE HALF YEARS AGO HE WORKED AS "STICKMAN" AT SANDS HOTEL, LAS VEGAS. IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THIS EMPLOYMENT HE OBTAINED OKAY FROM GUISEPPE TRAINA, NEW YORK.

CI POINTED OUT THIS DATE "GREASER GANG" BURIAL GROUNDS, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, N.J., LOCATED APPROXIMATELY TWO MILES FROM PARVIN STATE PARK ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. PRESENT OCCUPANT NOT KNOWN TO SOURCE NOR AGENTS HANDLING SOURCE. PRESENT OCCUPANT DID NOT OCCUPY THIS FARM AT TIME OF BURIALS.

CI ADVISED ANGELO BRUNO TO "MAKE" NEW MEMBERS IN LA COSA NOSTRA SECOND WEEK OF JUNE, 1964, IN CAMDEN COUNTY, N.J., AND SOURCE WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE. DETAILS AND RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING BURIAL GROUND AND LA COSA NOSTRA INITIATION CEREMONY WILL BE FURNISHED BY SEPARATE COMMUNICATION. BRUNO CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
