The following information classified "SECRET" and not to be disseminated without the approval of RCMP was furnished on the dates indicated:

On 10/30/70, RCMP advised PU Chao-min, New China News Agency (NCNA) representative, on 9/2/70 was contacted by a Mr. LIE (ph) who advised he knew SUSANXWARREN (ph) of New York. LIE further advised he (date not specified) and STERLING NEWBERRY and his wife had contacted WARREN to talk about the political situation in the US. NEWBERRY was described as a political activist in the US. The NEWBERRYS, about four years ago, had lost their teaching positions because of their political activities; allegedly, they now believe in MAO Tse-tung thought. LIE then presented PU with WARREN's telephone number, which is that listed to subject and her husband, and described her as being an ardent MAOist.

Information dated 5/20/71 indicated subject, as SUSAN WARREN, arrived in Ottawa from New York via Eastern Airlines on 4/17/71, and met with PU.

Subject mentioned she was in China in 1961, and had visited for a year and a half. The trip was made possible through TANG Ming-chao. In reply to PU's query, subject stated she had met ANNA LOUISE STRONG, with whom she was previously acquainted, while in China. Arrangements were made by PU for subject to meet with representatives of the People's Republic of China (PRC) Mission in Ottawa (5)

RCMP, on 7/28/71, furnished information indicating PU on 6/17/71 had been contacted by subject, who informed him she would travel to 0ttawa 6/19/71, as she had "some interesting things" to talk over with him.

Subject was met at the airport by PU on 6/19/71, and upon conclusion of the meeting, he drove her to the airport. (5)

Information from RCMP on 9/9/71 disclosed a source was advised by MA Kue-hsin, wife of LO Yi-ching, NCNA, that on 8/12/71, subject arrived in Ottawa and went directly to the PRC Embassy, where she met YAO Jen-liu. PU was also at the Embassy to meet subject. (5)

The agents who observed subject and her husband at the "China Daily News" on 7/11/71 were MICHAEL E. DENNEHY and EDWIN YEE.

Subject had been included in Priority I of the former SI. Review of her file does not reflect any change in her status is warranted and she will continue in Category I of the ADEX.

Investigative period of report overlaps that of the prior report as information from RCMP was not received in time for inclusion in prior report.

NY T-3, a confidential source abroad, advised RICHARD C. FRANK entered China from Hong Kong on September 29, 1971.

Employment

NY T-1, on December 23, 1971, stated to her know-ledge that subject, whom she previously advised was a free-lance writer, continues to hold the same occupation and apparently writes the articles from her place of residence.

NY T-4, on March 15, 1971, stated BERGMAN had advised in the recent past he had visited subject at her place of residence.

During the period January 9, 1971 to April 23, 1971, telephone number 242-0021, which is listed to subject and her husband, was called from the residence of BERGMAN.

On July 24, 1968, NY T-5 advised LEIBEL BERGMAN is one of the co-founders of the Revolutionary Union.

The Revolutionary Union (RU) was founded in early 1968 and is a militant, semi-clandestine organization. Its objectives, as set out in its publication, are the development of a united front against imperialism, the fostering of revolutionary working-class unity and leadership in struggle, and the formation of a communist party

NY T-9, a confidential source abroad, on September 7, 1971 advised subject departed Orly Airport, Paris, France, on August 16, 1971, en route to Peking, China. Subject was described as being a journalist. (5)

NY T-8 advised subject was observed at John F. Kennedy International Airport, NY, on November 11, 1971, to welcome the arrival of the delegation of the PRCMUN.

Subject advised source she had returned to the US on November 9, 1971.

NY T-6 advised LEIBEL BERGMAN, supra, had stated subject entered China separately from the Revolutionary Union and her husband and departed in the same manner.

The November 4-10, 1971 edition of the Chinese Communist English language publication, "Ta Kung Pao," published in Hong Kong, contained an article about subject's trip to China. A copy of the article is included in the Appendix.

Activities

On July 22, 1971, NY T-8 advised one of the initial meetings of the US-CPFA was held at the headquarters of the I wor Kuen (IWK), 24 Market Street, NY, NY, on July 18, 1971. Among those present were subject, SAMMY LEONG, an employee of the CDN, and CHAN Yu-man, CHARLIE LEE, ROBERT LEE, LORRAINE LEONG, JEAN YONEMURA and YANG Shao-chien, all members of the IWK.

The IWK was founded in 1969 by ethnic Chinese youth. It has its headquarters at 24 Market Street, NY, NY, where it distributes pro-MAOist literature. The I Wor Kuen publication, "Getting Together," proclaims support for the People's Republic of China as well as for revolutionary armed war.
