WF T-2 stated that Betancourt planned to publish existing problems and shortcomings of the Castro Government and analyze and interpret these items to be used as propaganda against Castro. Betancourt planned to call the magazine "Libertador"

WF T-2 noted that Betancourt spends most of his afternoons at the office of ELC and that he has phone service in the office under the name of the organization. (4)

WF T-3 learned on June 11, 1963, from Humberto Bertran who is related by marriage to Ernesto Betancourt, that Betancourt intended to become more and more involved with activities of ELC and asked Bertran if he would accept telephone calls for Betancourt at his home.

Although WF T-3 stated that Bertran did not explicitly agree to allow Betancourt to receive telephone calls at his home he, on the other hand, did not refuse to accept these calls. With reference to the above, WF T-3 advised on October 15, 1963, that he determined that only one telephone call was placed by Betancourt at Bertran's home to an unknown party in Miami, Florida, telephone number 305 - NE 5-4595. No other calls were received or made from Bertran's home from what WF T-3 could determine.

In connection with Betancourt's office space WF T-4 advised on September 30, 1963, he learned that ELC's office is located in Rooms 205 and 206, 1518 K Street, N.W., and Betancourt pays \$125 a month for rent and \$30 per month for phone service WF T-4 believed that Betancourt's expenses for ELC's office were defrayed by voluntary contributions from private individuals (U)
