April 20, 1962, subject was stopped by the Intelligence Division of the Dade County Public Safety Department in Miami.

On 5/1/62, subject and his attorney, HARVEY ST. JEAN, appeared Dade County SO, but refused to discuss any information related to his activities.

Referenced report of SA LENIHAN, page 9, sets out that in May, 1962, JAMES WILLIAM EGAN received a telephone call while in Denver, from SAM KAY, in which KAY berated EGAN for causing "racketeers to come around and visit him". EGAN stated that KAY informed him that SANTOS TRAFFICANTE had come to KAY's Office, informing KAY that he wanted the \$112,000 that EGAN and BRAY had given him.

Subject was next reported in Tampa on the afternoon of Saturday, May 12, 1962, when he was reported at the Columbia Restaurant, in the company of JAMES C. LONGO...

Former CS TP 51-C, a highly confidential source interested in activities at 2505 Bristol, Tampa, who is notain a position to testify, furnished information on 5/17/63, that Miss GEORGETTE, 9570 Harding Ave., Surfside, Miami Beach, Fla., apparently furnished a receipt dated 3/16/62 for \$30, from a Mrs. J. BRUNO, 8805 NE 9th Court (it has been previously reported that the subject had an apartment under the name JAMES BRUNO on Miami Beach, and therefore living in Miami Beach, he would have had access to the office of SAM KAY.).

At 11:30 A.M. 5/16/62, subject's car was in his drive-way at his residence, 523 NE 71st St., Miami, but neither subject nor his car were observed on 5/17/62 at his residence in Miami. On 5/18/62, subject was observed at the residence in Miami, and walso in the vicinity of 23rd St. and Collins Ave., Miami Beach.

It is noted that on 5/24/62, former CS TP 51-C, as above, furnished information which indicated there had been a customer's receipt, dated 4/25/62, from "LILLIE RUBIN" store, Miami Beach and Palm Beach, Fla., reflecting a sale to Mrs. BRUNO, 523 NE 71st St., in the amount of \$47.33. The receipt indicated customer "will call" for the merchandise, inasmuch as a \$20 deposit was made.

On 5/27/62, at 2:24 P.M., TRAFFICANTE was in the
