On 10/8/68, MM 1298-C-TE advised that SANTO TRAFFICANTE, JR., FRANK RAGANO, TRAFFICANTE attorney, and HUMBERTO TRUEBA ROJAS, traveled to Quito, Ecuador, on 10/3/68. RAGANO was accompanied by a woman named PATRICIA OSBORNE from Miami Beach, Florida, who was traveling to Ecuador because her husband had been killed in an airplane crash in Ecuador approximately three weeks previously. RAGANO was acting as her attorney, and OSBORNE allegedly paid for the expenses to Ecuador of RAGANO and TRAFFICANTE.

On arrival in Quito, Ecuador, the party flew immediately to Guayaquil, Ecuador, where TRUEBA
