
Reference is made to your letter of September 11, 1964. Dr. Herman L. TRACY, Classics Department, McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario was interviewed as requested. He stated that on August 29, 1964, while visiting in Kingston, Ontario, he had occasion to hold a brief conversation with GROSSI's wife, now Patricia Ann (Mrs. Jack) BOWEN, who resides at 36 Ellerbeck Street, Kingston.

2. Dr. TRACY related his conversation with Mrs. BOWEN and the only pertinent information regarding this case is to the effect that GROSSI stayed at the Bruce MacDonald Motor Hotel in Ottawa some time during the summer of 1964 and left without paying his bill.

3. Dr. TRACY has not heard from GROSSI since he was released from Kingston Penitentiary in 1960. Dr. TRACY did state that an inmate of Dorchester Penitentiary, Dorchester, New Brunswick, Ralph C. PARKS, had corresponded with GROSSI following his release from Kingston Penitentiary. If other enquiries now being conducted fail to provide results, we will attempt to have PARKS interviewed.

4. Local sources of information in the Hamilton area including the Credit Bureau, local police forces, employment agencies, etc. were checked but it does not appear that GROSSI is in that area at the present time.

5. Enquiries continue and you will be further advised.
