A Confidential Source abroad on February 5, 1965, furnished the following results of investigation:

AT NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA:

AT LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA:

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agents JOHN D. WALLACE and PAUL LUTHER:

Attempts were made to locate and interview DON DAWSC at 4077 West Third Street on February 23, 1965, and March 1, 1965, with negative results; however, DAWSON was interviewed at the Kipling Residence, 4077 West Third Street, on March 3, DAWSON stated that he had first become acquainted with the subject when he (DAWSON) was associating with a group of people who were employed by the Colonial Western Life Insur Company in Dallas, Texas, in about the middle of 1963.
