vestigation at Ottawa, Kingston, London and Montreal, Canada.  
Investigation also unsuccessful in locating subject at New  
Orleans, Los Angeles, Albany and Hudson, New York, Dallas  
and Weatherford, Texas. GROSSI HAS COMMITTED ARMED ROBBERY  
WITH A PISTOL IN 1956, AT SCARBOROUGH, ONTARIO, AND SHOULD BE  
CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS. - P -DETAILS:AT KINGSTON, ONTARIO, CANADA:

A Confidential Source abroad on February 5, 1965,  
furnished the following results of investigation:

Mr. LLOYD TRULL, 281 King Street, Kingston, Ontario,  
Vice-Principal, Kingston Collegiate and Vocational Institute,  
was interviewed and he advised that he was aware of the facts  
surrounding Mrs. PATRICIA BOWEN'S husband. Mrs. BOWEN is  
presently on the teaching staff at Queen Elizabeth Collegiate  
and Vocational Institute, Kingston, Ontario, being the head of  
the Classics Department. TRULL advised that Mrs. BOWEN was a  
close friend of Mr. VERNON READY, former Principal of Kingston  
Collegiate and Vocational Institute. In the summer of 1964  
the READYS moved to London, Ontario and since this time Mrs.  
BOWEN has been in constant contact with Mr. TRULL.

He also advised that he had been introduced to JOHN GROSSI, who was using the name JACK BOWEN, during the summer of 1964. This took place at the home of VERNON READY where the BOWEN'S were visiting. Since the READYS have moved from the Kingston area PATRICIA BOWEN has been a close friend of Mr. TRULLS and it would appear that she would confide in him should her husband contact her or have any of his friends do the same.

TRULL also advised that Mrs. BOWEN is residing at 36 Ellerbeck Avenue, Kingston with her two year old son and her mother, who babysits while she works. She is highly regarded as a teacher by her superiors and there is no indication that she is involved with her husband in any way. She associates with a small group of personal friends, these being mostly fellow teachers. It was also mentioned by TRULL that Mrs. BOWEN would proceed with divorce action should she be able to get in contact with her husband.

WILLIAM TATTON, 34 Ellerbeck Avenue, Kingston, Ontario Classification Officer, Kingston Penitentiary, who is well known to all members of this detachment, was interviewed regarding the possibility that he had noticed an American car in the vicinity of 36 Ellerbeck Avenue. He advised that he could not recall any such vehicle in the last few months but stated that he would notify this office should he notice anything that might indicate that GROSSI was in the area. TATTON also faintly remembers GROSSI as an inmate at Kingston Penitentiary.

AT OTTAWA, CANADA:

A Confidential Source abroad on February 15, 1965, advised that:

Inquiries have been conducted in Ottawa through the Department of Immigration where records reveal that GROSSI was deported from Canada at Black Rock, New York, October 7, 1953. At that time subject's occupation was shown as "Habitual Criminal", therefore, he has since been barred from Canada as an undesirable.

We have established that Ottawa telephone number 210-1527 is listed to Mrs. MARY A. MURRAY, 78 Fourth Avenue, Ottawa.

One PATRICIA ELLIOTT is a resident at this address and advised our investigator that GROSSI is her uncle. EDNA (Mrs. WILLIAM) ELLIOTT, who has been previously interviewed at Pembroke, Ontario, is Miss ELLIOTT'S mother. Miss ELLIOTT stated that she contacts her aunt, PATRICIA BOWEN, quite frequently at Kingston, Ontario. However, she has no knowledge as to the present whereabouts of GROSSI. We have been assured that she will advise our investigator if any further information of value comes to her attention.

AT LONDON, ONTARIO, CANADA:

A Confidential Source abroad on March 15, 1965, advised that inquiry had been made concerning the fact that subject's wife, PATRICIA BOWEN had been in contact with VERNON READY. This information was only concerning a possible visit with the READY family and had nothing whatsoever to do with the whereabouts of JOHN GROSSI.

AT NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA:

On February 16, 1965, JOHN MOORE, Manager, Playboy Club, advised that he had exhibited a photograph of JOHN CESAR GROSSI to personnel at the Playboy Club and no one recognized him as anyone they had been in contact with at any time.

AT LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA:

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agents JOHN D. WALLACE and PAUL LUTHER:

Attempts were made to locate and interview DON DAWSON at 4077 West Third Street on February 23, 1965, and March 1, 1965, with negative results; however, DAWSON was interviewed at the Kipling Residence, 4077 West Third Street, on March 3, 1965. DAWSON stated that he had first become acquainted with the subject when he (DAWSON) was associating with a group of people who were employed by the Colonial Western Life Insurance Company in Dallas, Texas, in about the middle of 1963. DAWSON stated that the subject at that time was, in his opinion, carrying on a clandestine affair with Mrs. MARY McCULLOM, wife of the president of Colonial Western Life Insurance Company. DAWSON stated that it was decided that he would teach the subject fundamentals of the export-import business and that they planned to go into business in Mexico where they would obtain quick silver and sell it in the United States. Mrs. McCULLOM told DAWSON that she would raise the necessary money for him if he would include the subject (who was known to him only as JACK BOWEN) as part of his export-import firm.
