SAM AND KELLY MANNARINO

The Pittsburgh Post Gazette, a Pittsburgh, Pa., daily newspaper, published an article on 6/9/58 written by Staff Writer VINCE JOHNSON which in part reported that the MANNARINOS' two million a year gambling establishment in New Kensington, Pa., was closed due to "pressure from the Federal Government." The article mentioned that the Internal Revenue Service was checking into the MANNARINOS' operation and the USM was looking for KELLY to serve him a subpoena for his appearance before a New York Grand Jury investigating the 11/14/57 Apalachin, New York, meeting.
